**Subject: Admission Schedule for 2009-10.**

**1. Schedule for Admission tests for classes II and above will also be displayed on Vidyalaya Notice Board.**

- Admission test will be based on syllabus of previous classes to which admission is being sought.
- An Admission test would be conducted in the following subjects:
  - a. PRIMARY CLASSES (Class II to V) - **English, Hindi & Maths**
  - b. MIDDLE CLASSES (Class VI to VIII) - **Hindi, English, Maths & General Knowledge**
  - c. SECONDARY CLASSES (Class IX & X) - **Hindi, English, Maths, Social Studies & Science**

**2. Attested copies of the following documents would be required to be submitted along with the application form for Registration.**

- a. For class I, certificate of age proof in the form of a birth certificate issued by the Competent Authority to register births. This will include Notified Area Committees like Municipal Corporation, extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat, Military Hospital or service records of Defence personnel.
- b. Age proof for class II & above the date of birth recorded in the transfer certificate issued by a school recognized by the state education department would be accepted.
- c. For grand children of Hon'ble Members of Parliament or KVS employees, a proof of relationship of either of the child's or parents with the Hon'ble Member of Parliament or KVS employee and a declaration of dependency would be needed.
- d. A certificate that the child belong to the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled tribe wherever applicable issued by the competent authority. A certificate in respect of either parent may be accepted initially for the purpose of admission if this certificate is not available for child.
- e. A certificate from the Civil Surgeon/ Rehabilitation Center or any other Competent Authority defined by Govt. of India O.M. No. 36035/5/88 Estt. (SCT) dated 4th May 1999 certifying the child to be handicapped, wherever applicable. In cases where the handicap of the child can be visually seen by the Principal, the child may be accepted as handicapped even without a certificate.
- f. A service certificate showing the number of transfers during the preceding 7 years duly signed and stamped by the Head of Office bearing the name, designation and other relevant particulars.
- g. A certificate of retirement for uniformed Defence employee if so.

Note:

1. A child must be 5 years old for admission in class I & 6 years old for admission in class II **on 31-03-2009** and for subsequent classes, the eligible age will be reckoned again with reference to 30<sup>th</sup> September with proportionate increase over 5 years. An upper age limit for admission is fixed as the minimum age limit plus two years.
2. Mere registration will not confer a right to admission
3. Incomplete application forms shall normally be rejected. In case of vacancies remaining, the Principal may allow completion of the forms later at his discretion.
